STRIKE DAYS

We have been advised by the City Council that NEU Teaching members are proposing to take more strike action on 27th April and 2nd May 2023, as a further step in their national dispute over pay.

Having considered carefully the operational and health and safety implications, the following classes will not be open:

Thursday 27th April - 1A, 3A, 3B, 4A & 4B Tuesday 2nd May- RA, RB, 1A, & 4B

All other classes will be open. Again, if you are a key worker parent of children in the classes above and need support please let us know, however staffing is limited so please try and find an alternative if possible. We will contact parents of vulnerable children.

Please note, that just because a class is closed it does not necessarily reflect on a teacher's individual choice to strike, we have made these decisions based on the health and safety needs of the school. This could also be a fluid situation and there may be changes on the day. I am still hopeful that the government and the NEU will come to a decision before then!

If you have already paid for your child's school dinner, this will be credited to your account.

If your child has free school meals you will receive another voucher to cover lunch on the day.

KINDNESS WEEK

Next week, we will be taking part in Stoke Heath's Kindness week. Our aim is to promote kindness within our school and campaign against bullying.

On Monday, we are asking children to wear odd socks, coloured socks or roll their socks down as a way of creating awareness and to emphasise that being kind is part of our values.

ONLINE SAFETY

Google Family Link App
