

Year 5 Spring Term 1 Overview

Maths

In Maths lessons, we will be developing our mathematical skills, reasoning and problem-solving. We will be working through topics such as: Number and Place Value, Multiplication and Divison, Fractions and Geometry. In Counting lessons, learning will focus on on counting skills, aiming to develop efficiency and accuracy. Embedding number facts and times tables ensures children can apply these to problem solving questions.





We will be teaching both Reading and Writing through our English lessons. We will explore Macbeth and use a non-fiction text to write a biography about Jesse Owens. Children will write a recount based on the text 'Everest' which links to our Mountains unit. We are also focussing on improving the children's reading stamina and the accuracy of their comprehension answers.

In our SPaG lessons, we will be developing a secure understanding of the Key Stage 2 curriculum for Spelling and Grammar, and applying these rules in our writing.
