Maths

In Maths lessons, we will be developing our mathematical skills, reasoning and problem-solving.

In Arithmetic lessons, we will learn to choose and use an appropriate written or mental method when adding, subtracting, multiplying and dividing. We will also be learning to calculate with fractions and decimals. We will also be focussing on developing our rapid recall of number facts and times tables.



Science

Children will build upon their understanding of light and how we see things.

In our next topic, children will learn about the topic 'Living Things'.
